TRS premium rates are established annually on a CY basis in accordance with Section 1076d of Title 10, United States Code (U.S.C.), and Section 199.24 of Title 32, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). The TRS monthly premiums for CY 2023 shall be the rates listed in the table below:

TYA premium rates are established annually on a CY basis in accordance with 10 U.S.C. § 1110b and 32 CFR § 199.26. The TYA monthly premiums for CY 2023 shall be the rates listed in the table below:

#### **How we help**

##### **Legal advice**

Legal Aid staff attorneys offer advice and counsel to applicants seeking answers to legal questions in our branch offices, through our toll-free Legal Aid Line (888-529-5277), or at after-hours clinics. An online application for some services is available at [www.lanwt.org](http://www.lanwt.org).

##### **Representation**

Staff attorneys attend hearings or file legal action on behalf of individual clients or community groups accepted for full representation.

##### **Pro bono volunteers**

Legal Aid has a successful pro bono volunteer program that pairs private attorneys with low-income clients needing legal help.

#### **Partnerships**

Our firm partners with law schools, social service agencies, neighborhood groups, and local bar associations to deliver legal information and services to members of the community.

#### **Who qualifies**

Free legal assistance is provided to low-income groups and individuals who meet eligibility guidelines. Eligibility is determined case by case.

#### **Helping clients with a variety of civil legal issues**

- Protection from domestic violence
- Landlord/tenant matters, including evictions and lockouts
- Environmental justice
- Consumer protection, including identity theft and rip-offs
- Federal tax issues, including liens and levies
- Access to education for children with special needs
- Divorce
- SNAP/Food Stamps, Medicare, Medicaid
- Debt collection
- Driver license reinstatement
- Employment matters, including discrimination complaints and unemployment compensation
- Expunction/non-disclosure of eligible criminal records
